**The UK Civil Aviation Authority (CAA):** It is a legal requirement to register with the UK CAA any unmanned aerial vehicle, model aircraft or drone (hereafter known as drone) that is:

- weighing between 250g and 20kg
- under 250g if it has a camera
- any drone under 250g can be flown without any training if risk to people and property is low.

Furthermore, both the **flyer** and or **operator** need register themselves and obtain individual CAA Flier / Operator Identification. These registrations need annual renewal and currently cost £9 per year.

If your **drone weighs 20kg** or more you must have valid third-party insurance, regardless of the drone's use.

**Durlston Country Park** is a National Nature Reserve. This consists of public open space, much of which is a Site of Special Scientific Interest. As the access authority Dorset Council has a duty of care for the safety and privacy of its staff and visitors at Durlston. In addition, as the landowner it must take due care to avoid any potentially harmful impact upon the habitat and wildlife therein. The site is managed to deter disturbance to ground nesting and cliff nesting birds.

Please not that only Visual Line of Sight (VLOS) flights are permitted on or over Durlston. This means that the drone must be clearly seen by the remote pilot when it is airborne. This is to protect:

- o Visitor safety
- o Visitor privacy
- Avoid disturbance to nesting birds

In addition, at Durlston Country Park all users must also:

- Apply and receive written approval for specified Durlston drone operations
- Provide evidence of :
  - A valid Civil Aviation Permission for Commercial Operations
  - $\circ$  Current Public Liability Insurance with a minimum of £5 million cover
- Adhere to:
  - The Durlston Drone Code of Conduct

Please not that only **Visual Line of Sight (VLOS)** flights are permitted on or over Durlston. This means that the drone must be clearly seen by the remote pilot when it is airborne. This is to protect:

- Visitor safety
- Visitor privacy
- Avoid disturbance to nesting birds
